Leave a gift in your will

A gift in your will is a meaningful way to support future generations across Whanganui, Rangitīkei and Ruapehu.

Sport Whanganui works alongside schools, clubs, whānau, community groups and partners to help people take part in sport, play and active recreation. Our role is to create opportunities, strengthen local capability and help remove barriers that can prevent people from being active.

Why your gift matters

Every gift can contribute to positive, lasting change across our region. A gift in your will could help to:

- reduce barriers such as programme costs, fees, equipment and transport
- support tamariki and rangatahi to participate and build confidence
- strengthen clubs, volunteers and community organisations
- help Sport Whanganui respond to changing community needs

There is no right amount to leave. Gifts may be a percentage of an estate, a set amount, the remainder of an estate, or a specific asset.

Suggested wording for your will

The following wording may help your solicitor prepare or update your will:

"I give to Sport Whanganui, registered charity number CC33883, [insert percentage, amount, residue or description of asset] to be used for its general charitable purposes. I declare that the receipt of an authorised officer of Sport Whanganui will be a full and sufficient discharge to my trustees."

This wording is provided as a guide only. Your solicitor or legal adviser may recommend wording that better reflects your wishes and circumstances.

Leaving your gift for general charitable purposes gives Sport Whanganui the flexibility to direct it where it is needed most.
